

Minutes of August 1, 2022

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday August 1, 2022 at 9 a.m., Chairperson Ed Kathrens, Commissioner Keith Kelly and Commissioner Dan Brenner were present. County Clerk Kathy Mick recorded the minutes.

Floyd Deacon, Jr and Brenda Henry met with the Commissioners concerning a letter Floyd received from the County concerning an incident at Banner Creek Reservoir. The Commissioners will meet with the County Councilor this afternoon and set up a hearing and send out notice to Mr. Deacon. Mr. Deacon stated that everything stated in the letter was done by someone else.

The City of Whiting provided a letter stating the city would use the \$25,000 ARPA funds allocated by the County Commissioners to paint their Water Tower and maintain the City Sewer.

The City of Denison provided a letter stating the city would use the \$25,000 ARPA funds allocated by the County Commissioners to clean and camera their sewer lines.

The City of Soldier provided a letter stating the city would use the \$25,000 ARPA funds allocated by the County Commissioners on their water tower project.

The Commissioners signed a letter of support for Giant Communications for fiber-optic broadband service in the Denison area.

Keith signed the mural agreement with as presented. Dan seconded and the motion carried 3/0

Dan Brenner came up with the incentive to pay employees \$500 if they can bring a good employee to Road and Bridge for a year. At that time the new employee and the employee that introduced them to Jackson County gets \$500 each.

Signed occupy right of way for Rural Water District #1 to supply service to Dale & Elaine Jones at 12105 T Road in Sec 13. Twp 9, Rang 15.

Accepted the only fuel bid submitted. Haag Oil for \$29,560 for 4,000 gallons diesel and 4,000 gallons unleaded.

Declined the budget request from Three Rivers in the amount of \$1,200.

Chad Gerhardt from Midstate's Materials invited the Commissioner to a Quarry Tour on Wednesday August 10th.

Keith made the motion to approve the minutes of July 25th as written. Dan seconded and motion carried 3.0
